

Comparison of the petroleum industry contract and the general identical conditions for the consulting services contracts and the Planning and Management Organization code no 4318, and the solution of its deficiencies and challenges

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Abstract

According to the principles of concluding all consulting services agreements, the general conditions of consultation contracts or Code No. 3418 of the planning organization of the country are the requirements of the agreement and the contract. It sets up the scope, limits, authority, responsibilities and responsibilities of the employer and the consultant and the agents who involved in the organization of the advisory services, and tries to create the least ambiguity in the provision of advisory services, and while the private conditions should not be in conflict with the general terms of the contract, but misinterpretations, lack of transparency in common or similar terms provisions of the two sets will create a challenge in the services. Considering that the last revision of the collection was in 1379 and since that date no changes have been made. And there are also differences with the Comparison of the Petroleum Industry Contract and general the general identical conditions for the consulting services contracts and the Planning and Management Organization Code No 4318, which needs to be compared, investigated and amended with the changing technology and project management and the specificity of the oil industry projects. In this article, the challenging and old clauses and clauses that appear to be inconsistent with the current situation, the review and the proposed strategy and suggestions to amend the provisions and the above mentioned are presented.
